WINE ANALYSIS

VARIETIES: 100% Petite Sirah

AVA & VINEYARDS: Horse Heaven Hills AVA (Zephyr Ridge Vineyard)

HARVEST: Mid-October

This vintage was a change from recent growing seasons, starting cool with late bloom that delayed harvest by two weeks. However, an unusually warm fall allowed fruit to fully ripen.

WINE MAKING

METHOD: Two chosen vineyard blocks
Fermented separately/ 12 day contact/ Light press

WINE MAKER: Wade Wolfe

PRODUCTION: 738 Cases

WINE DATA

ALCOHOL: 14.5%

AGING IN OAK BARRELS: American Oak (29 Months)

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of vanilla, clove, coffee and tobacco. On the palate, the bold red wine has hints of mulberry, black cherry and pepper corns. The finish has hints of raspberry, light black tea and caramel.
